


# Machine pieced mug rug or table topper with hexagons



The hexagons measure 2" between to opposite flat sides.  
To make larger you can increase the size of both the hexagon and the triangle templates by an equal percentage on a copy machine as follows:

3" hexagon: increase size by 150 percent.

4" hexagon: increase size by 200 percent.

1.5" hexagon: decrease by 75 percent.

1" hexagon: decrease by 200 percent.

(Don't forget to use the same percentages for the triangles).

Sew a triangle to two opposite sides of the 6 green hexagons.



Sew a triangle to just one side of 2 green hexagons.




Sew two triangle to the same side of 4 green hexagons.




(As long as you don't use directional fabric it does not matter on which side as you can just rotate the pieces).


Sew a triangle to two opposite sides of the 6 orange and 1 dark red hexagon.




Layout:

Repeat for the next rows and then stitch the rows together.



To make a larger piece, you could make the templates bigger, or you could add hexagons and triangles. The hexagons can be all different colors, but the triangles are shared by the adjoining hexies and look better if they are all the same color.

Optional: Add a border and then layer with batting and backing and finish with binding in the usual way. If you hate sewing on binding, you can also place the backing face down on the front of the little quilt and stitch through all layers (batting, pieced quilt, and backing), 1/4 inch from the outside edge. Leave an opening in one side and turn inside out. Push out the corners so they look good and sew or glue the opening closed. Top stitch close to the outside edge.

Add quilting, if so desired.
